Upon determination by the Board of Corrections that a reallocation of resources within the Division of Community Correction and Division of Correction is necessary for the efficient and effective operation of the divisions, the Board, with approval of the Governor and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, shall have the authority to instruct the division directors, to request from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a transfer of positions, programs, funds, appropriations, and line-item appropriations within or between existing and newly created divisions, offices, sections, or units of the divisions. If it is determined that the requested transfer should be made, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary transfer documents to reflect the transfers upon the fiscal records of the State Treasurer, the State Auditor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the Divisions of Correction and Community Correction. Provided, however, that the Board shall be limited to submitting no more than two requests, encompassing a single purpose listed in this section, during any fiscal year per division.

Transfer authority shall further be limited to no more than five percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation, funding, and positions specific to each agency. However, there shall be no fund transfers to or from the County Jail Reimbursement Fund. A Reallocation of Resources Transfer shall be limited to the following specific purposes:

- a) Costs to open and operate temporary beds;
- b) Payment of Debt Service;
- c) Payment of Overtime Expenses;
- d) Unanticipated increases for medical or private prison contracts;
- e) Construction/renovation/equipping of new beds;
- f) Deficits in Farm or Industry Program;
- g) Losses not covered by insurance proceeds;
- h) Costs of personnel for critical services necessary to carry out the mission of the agency.

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by

1 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and  
 2 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by  
 3 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly  
 4 has determined that the Division of Correction and the Division of Community  
 5 Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to

15 services and operating expenses in the Shared Services Paying Account  
16 Appropriation by the Department of Corrections.

17 (2) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the transfer  
18 of funds and appropriations to the Shared Services Paying Account  
19 appropriation section of this act on the books of the Treasurer of State, the  
20 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

21 (3) The transfer authority provided to the department in  
22 subdivision (a)(2) of this section may be used to make transfers only within  
23 the department's appropriation act or between other appropriation acts  
24 authorized for the department.

25 (4) The provisions of this section shall be in effect from the  
26 date of passage through June 30, 2023.

27  
28 SECTION 47. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. *Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 27,*  
29 *Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:*  
30 12-27-150. Death benefit.

31 (a) Subject to the approval of the Board of Corrections, the Secretary  
32 of the Department of Corrections may authorize the payment of a death benefit  
33 from special revenues held by the Department of Corrections or its various  
34 divisions to any department employee killed in the line of duty.

35 (b) The amount of the death benefit shall not exceed five thousand  
36 dollars (\$5,000).



1 (c) The secretary shall promulgate any rules necessary to implement  
2 this section.

3 (d) Funds distributed under this section are subject to audit by  
4 Arkansas Legislative Audit.

5  
6 SECTION 48. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
7 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
8 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
9 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

15  
16 SECTION 49. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
18 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
19 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24  
25 SECTION 50. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after July 1,  
26 2022.
