8	"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR MATCHING GRANTS FOR
9	THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING WARNING AND COMMUNICATIONS
10	EQUIPMENT BY THE LOCAL OFFICES OF EMERGENCY SERVICES AND
11	KEY STATE AGENCIES ASSIGNED AN EMERGENCY ROLE UNDER THE
12	STATE OF ARKANSAS EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN FOR THE
13	BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
14	PURPOSES."

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
17	
18	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby
19	appropriated, to the Office of Emergency Services, to be payable from the
20	General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for matching
21	grants for the acquisition of warning and communications systems for the
22	biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the sum of \$100,000.
23	
24	SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
25	authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
26	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
27	the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
28	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
29	Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions
30	Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
31	applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
32	Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
33	disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 35

36 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which 2 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent 9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 11 SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the 12 SECTION 5. 13 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such 14 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which 15 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this 16 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 17 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict 18 19 with this Act are hereby repealed. 20 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 22 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of 23 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year 24 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1991 is essential to the 25 operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, 26 and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the 27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1991 could work irreparable harm 28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1991. 32 33 APPROVED: 4-9-91 34
