# For An Act To Be Entitled 


#### Abstract

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARK. CODE ANN. §14-229-101(a) AND (b) TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS ON THE INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO TWELVE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE ADDITIONAL MEMBERS BE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF POLLUTION CONTROL AND ECOLOGY, THE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION, AND THE ARKANSAS GEOLOGICAL COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ark. Code Ann. §14-229-101(a) and (b) are hereby amended to read as follows:
"(a) There is established an advisory committee, to be known as the 'Individual Sewage Disposal Systems Advisory Committee,' for the purpose of making recommendations, advising, and providing assistance to the Division of Sanitarian Services of the Department of Health concerning the utilization and application of alternate and experimental individual sewage disposal systems.
(b) The advisory committee shall consist of twelve (12) members, to be appointed as follows:
(1) A member of the Arkansas Home Builders Association, to be appointed by the president of the association;
(2) A member of the Arkansas Real Estate Commission, to be appointed by a majority vote of the commission;
(3) A member of the Arkansas Realtors Association, to be appointed by the president of the association;
(4) One (1) member who shall be a currently-serving or former member of the board of a suburban improvement district or an officer or member of an association of property owners created by and pursuant to state law and organized for the purpose of maintaining common facilities, including sewage
disposal facilities, in unincorporated subdivisions in this state, to be named by the Governor. However, in making the appointment, the Governor shall name a person who has been a developer or a member or officer of the board of a development company that has developed large unincorporated subdivisions in two (2) or more counties in this state;
(5) Two (2) members of the Septic Tank Research Program of the University of Arkansas, to be named by the President of the University of Arkansas;
(6) The Director of the Division of Engineering, Department of Health;
(7) The Program Administrator of General Sanitation, Division of Sanitarian Services, Department of Health;
(8) The Director of the Division of Sanitarian Services, Department of Health;
(9) The Director of the Arkansas Department Pollution Control and Ecology or his designee;
(10) The Director of the Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission or his designee; and
(11) The State Geologist with the Arkansas Geological Commission or his designee."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
