Arkansas Code 14-284-207(a) is hereby amended to read as 16 follows: The quorum court of each county wherein is located a fire 17 "(a) 18 protection district formed for fire protection purposes shall establish the 19 service area of the fire protection districts to not exceed a radius of five 20 (5) miles from the fire station." 21 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature 22 23 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 24 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 25 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to 26 27 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 28 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without 29 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 30 Act are declared to be severable. 31 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are 32 33 hereby repealed. 34 35 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 36 General Assembly that the present law pertaining to the establishment of

	provide that the quorum court may establish the service area of fire
	protection districts; that this Act so provides; and that this Act should go
	into effect immediately in order to clarify the power of the quorum courts as

7	this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
8	health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
9	and approval.
