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                     COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

14 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

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         SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

26 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
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1	SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
2	application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
3	invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
4	can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
5	end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.
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7	SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
8	with this Act are hereby repealed.
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10	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
11	Seventy-Eighth General Assembly meeting in First Extraordinary Session, that
12	funds provided by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of
13	the Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division are,
14	due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance
15	and Administration - Revenue Services Division to continue to provide
16	essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
17	the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -
18	Revenue Services Division to continue such services; and that a delay in the
19	effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
20	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
21	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
22	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
23	force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
