## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 24-10-301(d) TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT OF A PREEMPLOYMENT PHYSICAL PRIOR TO BEING COVERED UNDER THE LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."


#### Abstract

Subtitle "AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT OF A PREEMPLOYMENT PHYSICAL PRIOR TO BEING COVERED UNDER THE LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM."


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (d) of Arkansas Code § 24-10-301 is hereby amended to read as follows:
"(d) (1) When covering a person first employed in paid service as a fire fighter or police officer on or after July 1, 1985, the employer shall require an employment physical examination of the employee, under criteria established by the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System Board.
(2) The employer shall submit a copy of the examination to the system within thirty (30) days of the date of hire."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
act are declared to be severable.
