23	SECTION 1. Arkansas	Code 6-15-1004 (a)(1) is a	mended to read as follows:
24	"(a)(1) The Genera	l Education Division of the	Department of Education
25	shall develop and present	to the State Board of Educ	ation a proposed plan for
26	working toward integrating statewide curriculum frameworks, student		
27	performance assessment tools, and professional development programs to support		
28	restructuring the Arkansas education system. In developing the plan the

32	SECTION 2. Arkansas	Code 6-15-1006 (a) is amen	ded to read as follows:
33	"(a) The General E	ducation Division of the De	partment of Education
34	shallmake available to all schools and school districts involved in a		
35	restructuring process the training, technical assistance, networking and other		
36	support they require. In performing these duties the Division may seek the		

assistance of any national organization for educational reform. The director
shall designate not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty-five (25) schools
or school districts which have begun the restructuring process to serve as
examples for other schools and school districts."

6 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 6-15-1008 (a)(1) is amended to read as follows: 7 "(a)(1) The leadership and support of the General Education Division of 8 the Department of Education is essential to facilitate the process of 9 restructuring the Arkansas education system. In order to fulfill this 10 function, the role, mission, operations, and resources of the division need to 11 be substantially reoriented and the staff needs training and support. The 12 General Education Division of the Department of Education shall develop a plan 13 to accomplish this. In developing the plan the Division may seek the 14 assistance of any national organization for educational reform."

16 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent 17 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas 18 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 19

20 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 21 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 22 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 23 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 24 act are declared to be severable.
