18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §27-16-701(d) is hereby amended to read as
21 follows:

22 "(d) (1) (A) Every application for an instruction permit or for an
23 operator's or chauffeur's license by a person less than eighteen (18) years
24 old on October 1 of any year shall be accompanied by proof of receipt of a
25 high school diploma or its equivalent or enrollment and regular attendance in
26 a public, private, or parochial school; proof that such person is being
27 provided schooling at home as described in §6-15-501 et seq.; or proof that
28 such person is enrolled in a postsecondary vocational-technical program, a
29 community college, or a two-year or four-year institution of higher education.

30 (B) Regular attendance shall be attendance in compliance
31 with the established written policy of the school district or school
32 concerning truancy.

33 (2) After July 1, 1993, such person shall present proof of a C
34 average for the previous semester or grading period in order to be issued a
35 license.
