1 State of Arkansas A Bill **ACT 972 OF 1993** 2 **79th General Assembly** HOUSE BILL 1313 3 Regular Session, 1993 By: Representative McGinnis 6 For An Act To Be Entitled 7 "AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 24, CHAPTER 7, SUBCHAPTER 7 OF THE R ARKANSAS CODE OF 1987, ANNOTATED, TO PERMIT THE ROLLOVER 9 OF ELIGIBLE RETIREMENT PLAN DISTRIBUTIONS FROM THE TEACHER 10 RETIREMENT SYSTEM MADE TO MEMBERS OR OTHER ELIGIBLE RETIREMENT PLANS OR QUALIFIED PAYEES; TO DECLARE AN 12 EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES." 13 14 Subtitle 15 "AN ACT TO PERMIT THE ROLLOVER OF ELIGIBLE RETIREMENT PLAN 17 DISTRIBUTIONS FROM TEACHER RETIREMENT MADE TO MEMBERS OR QUALIFIED PLANS." 18 19 20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 21 SECTION 1. Title 24, Chapter 7, Subchapter 7 of Arkansas Code of 1987, 22 23 Annotated, is hereby amended to add a new Section § 24-7-719 to read as 24 follows: "24-7-719. Rollover of distributions. 2.5 (a) As used in this section: 26 27 (1) Direct rollover means the payment of an eligible 28 distribution to an individual retirement arrangement or another employer 29 benefit plan. 3 0 Eligible rollover distribution means that portion of a 31 distribution which may be rolled over to an individual retirement arrangement 32 or to another employer benefit plan. (3) Eligible retirement plan means an IRA (individual 33 34 retirement account or individual retirement annuity or individual retirement 35 arrangement) or another employer benefit plan which accepts direct rollovers. 36 (b) Beginning January 1, 1993, should a member, or spouse, if the

1 member is deceased, elect to make a direct rollover of a distribution from the 2 Teacher Retirement System to an eligible retirement plan of all or part of his 3 eligible rollover distribution, the amount shall be paid to the trustee of the 4 eligible retirement plan. (c) Subsection (b) of this section shall apply to distributions made 6 under Arkansas Code §§ 24-7-709, 24-7-710, 24-7-711 and 24-7-716." 7 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 9 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code 10 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 11 If any provision of this act or the application thereof to 12 SECTION 3. 13 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect 14 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without 15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this 16 act are declared to be severable. 17 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are 18 19 hereby repealed. 20 SECTION 5. Emergency. It is hereby found and determined by the 22 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly that changes in the federal Internal Revenue 23 Code and federal IRS regulations have made several provisions of the Teacher 24 Retirement System law in need of revision and updating, that the law needs to 25 be updated in order to prevent an unfair tax impact on the system s members 26 and dependents, and that certain changes in the Teacher Retirement System law 27 are necessary to efficiently and effectively administer the Teacher Retirement 28 System. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this act 29 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 30 safety shall be in full force and effect retroactive to July 1, 1993. 31 APPROVED: 4/9/93 32 33 34
