	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19	SECTION 1. It shall be within the municipal affairs and authority of
20	any municipality in the state of Arkansas to authorize, by municipal
21	ordinance, any owner of a golf cart to operate the golf cart upon the city
22	streets of the municipality, provided, however, operation shall not be
23	authorized on city streets which are also designated as federal or state
24	highways or as a county road. The municipality may authorize the operation of
25	golf carts on city streets only from the owner's place of residence to the
26	golf course and to return from the golf course to the owner's residence. When
27	authorized by the municipality to operate on the city streets and limited to
28	the circumstances and provisions of this act, there shall be no motor vehicle
29	registration or license necessary to operate the golf cart on the public
30	street. The term "municipality" as used in this act means any city of the
31	first class, city of the second class, or an incorporated town.
32	
33	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
34	are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
35	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

 2 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 3 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 4 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
