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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-95-105(c)(4) is amended to read as follows
22	"(4) Credentialing information received and collected by the board and
23	furnished by the board to a credentialing organization shall be <u>confidential</u>
24	in nature and shall be used solely for credentialing and the renewal of
	credentials. The board may disclose such credentialing information as
26	provided in this act and;
27	(A) In disciplinary hearing before the board or in any subsequen
28	trial or appeal of a board action or order, or
29	(B) To any physician licensing or disciplinary authorities of
30	other jurisdictions, or
31	(C) Pursuant to an order of a court of competent jurisdiction."
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33	SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
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35	Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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1	SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
2	any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
3	other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
4	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
5	act are declared to be severable.
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7	SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
8	hereby repealed.
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10	SECTION . EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that hospitals, credentialing organizations
12	and insurance companies are in need of physician credentialing information
13	collected by the Arkansas State Medical Board; that said information should be
14	privileged and the sharing of said information should be protected so as to
15	enhance the credentialing process of the medical providers; that said
16	confidentiality of credentialing information does not now exist. Therefore an
17	emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for
18	the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective
19	on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved
20	$\underline{\text{nor}}$ vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the
21	period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is
22	vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective
23	on the date the last house overrides the veto.
