    SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 23-111-308 is amended to read as follows:
    " 23-111-308. Employees and patrons.
    (a) A franchise holder shall not omploy in any capacity any minori nor
shall the franchise holder allow any minor to be a patron at the race track
    No franchise holder shall permit any person under eighteen (18) years of age
    to be a patron of the pari-mutuel or certificate system of wagering conducted
    or supervised by it.
    (b) The commission shall have the right to require that every franchise
holder shall employ residents of the State of Arkansas to the extent of eighty
percent (80%) of the employees engaged in any greyhound race meet.
SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
