19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 21-5-402 is amended to read as follows:
22	"21-5-402. Members.
23	(a)(1) There is hereby created the Arkansas State Employee and
24	Public School Personnel Board composed of the following eleven (11)
25	twelve (12) voting members:
26	(A) A state employee to be selected by the Arkansas State
27	Employees Association;
28	(B) A certified classroom teacher to be selected by the
29	Arkansas Education Association or his designee;
30	(C) The Insurance Commissioner or his designee;
31	(D) One (1) public school employee to be appointed by the
32	Governor;
33	(E) One (1) state employee to be appointed by the Governor;
34	(F) The chairman of the House Insurance and Commerce
35	Committee and the chairman of the Senate Insurance and Commerce
36	Committee;

1 (G) Three (3) members who are business owners or risk 2 managers in private industry to be appointed by the Governor. 3 (H) One additional member position which shall be filled alternately by a retired teacher selected by the Arkansas Retired Teachers Association and by a retired state employee appointed by the Governor. This position shall first be filled by a retired teacher for a term of four (4) years, then by a retired state employee for a term of 7 four (4) years and four-year terms thereafter shall be alternated between a retired teacher and a retired state employee. 9 10 - (I) In addition, there shall be one (1) member who is a 11 doctor. 12 (2) However, any appointee who has a conflict of interest shall be disqualified to serve. 13 14 (b)(1) Members appointed by the Governor shall be appointed for terms of four (4) years. 15 16 (2) Vacancies in the Governor-appointed positions shall be filled 17 by appointment of the Governor for the unexpired term. (c) Chairmen or vice chairmen shall be elected by the board to 18 serve two-year terms." 19 2.0 21 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent 22 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the 23 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 2.4 25 26 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can

27 2.8 be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to 29 this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable. 3.0
