BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
    SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-4-903 (a) is hereby amended to read as
follows
    "(a)(1) Except for special authorization, by the baxd,

of the State, setting out the reasons thexefore, the daily allowances
reimbursement for meals and lodging for any individual travelex shall not
exceed the sum of fifty-five dollars ($55.00) per day while traveling within

as shall be required in the state travel procedures and shall be
executed in behalf of each individual traveler for each special authorized
occasion. Provided however, that requests for special authorization by
employees of institutions of higher education shall be subject to the approval
of the chief executive officer of the institution and not the Department of

    (3) Under such emergency conditions as shall be determined by the
Governor, the limitations of this subsection with respect to meals and lodging
may be waived or modified."
    SECTION 2. Arkansas code 19-6-701(b) is hereby amended by adding the
following subsection:
    "(8) Reimbursements to state agencies for cost sharing purposes."
    SECTION 3. CODE. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
SECTION 5. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the Eighty-First General Assembly that the appropriate reimbursement of travel expenses borne
by employees of the State of Arkansas should be provided for and that the
provisions of this Act are necessary for proper fiscal administration.
Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being
necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1997.
