## Subtitle

AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT ORAL HEALTH INSTRUCTION INTO PUBLIC SCHOOL CURRICULA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) The Department of Education shall adopt oral health standards as part of the Arkansas physical education and health curriculum framework.
(b) The Department of Education shall work with public schools to establish an educational program to inform, train, and educate students concerning the importance of achieving and maintaining good oral health.
(c) Curricula shall be designed according to objectives established by the department.
(d) The objectives shall be grade specific and shall be incorporated into the appropriate existing health and science curricula.
(e) It is the intent of this section that the curricula shall be implemented gradually, on a basis to be determined by the department, beginning no later than the fall semester 2005, with early elementary curricula and reaching full implementation at the high school level no later than the fall semester of 2011.
(f) The department shall enlist the voluntary assistance of
appropriate dental health professionals, organizations, and departments as necessary to achieve the purposes of this section. /s/ Gullett
