- 2 <u>(2)</u> The committee may meet at such places within the state as it deems appropriate.
 - (c) At all joint meetings of the committee, a quorum shall consist of a majority of the Senate members of the committee and a majority of the House members of the committee.
 - (d) All votes taken at each joint meeting of the committee shall be by separate Senate vote and separate House vote, and no motion shall pass unless it receives a favorable vote of the majority of the members of the House committee and a favorable vote of the majority of the members of the Senate committee.
 - (e) Members of the committee shall be entitled to per diem and mileage at the rate provided by law to be paid from funds appropriated for payment of per diem and mileage for attendance at meetings of interim committees of the House and Senate.
- (f)(1)(A) When meeting as a joint committee, the committee may, upon
 approval of a majority of the House membership of the committee and a
 majority of the Senate membership of the committee, subpoena persons,
 documents, and records.
 - (B) However, no action of the joint committee regarding the exercise of the subpoena power shall be taken except upon notice of at least one (1) week to all members of the committee or upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the House membership of the committee and two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Senate membership of the committee.
 - (2)(A) If the House members meet as a separate committee under subsection (b), the House committee may, upon approval of a majority of the membership of the House committee, subpoena persons, documents, and records.
- 28 (B) However, no action of the House committee regarding
 29 the exercise of the subpoena power shall be taken except upon notice of at
 30 least one (1) week to all members of the House committee or upon a two-thirds
 31 (2/3) vote of the membership of the House committee.
