22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-127 is amended to read as follows:
25 5-14-127. Sexual assault in the fourth degree.

26 (a)(1) A person commits sexual assault in the fourth degree if, *being*
27 *twenty (20) years of age or older*, the person engages in sexual intercourse,
28 or deviate sexual activity, ~~or sexual contact~~ with another person, not the
29 person's spouse, who is less than sixteen (16) years of age; or

30 (2) The person engages in sexual contact with another person,
31 not the person's spouse, who is less than sixteen (16) years of age.

32 (b)(1) Sexual assault in the fourth degree under subdivision
33 (a)(1) of this section is a ~~Class A misdemeanor~~, Class D felony.

34 (2) Sexual assault in the fourth degree under subdivision (a)(2)
35 of this section is a Class A misdemeanor if the person only engages in sexual
36 contact with another person as described in subdivision (a)(2) his section.
