21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-14-2210 is amended to read as follows:
24 27-14-2210. Vehicles or engines without manufacturers' numbers.

25 (a) Any person who knowingly buys, receives, disposes of, sells,
26 offers for sale, or has in his possession any motor vehicle or engine removed
27 from a motor vehicle, from which the manufacturer's serial or engine number
28 or other distinguishing number or identification mark or number placed
29 thereon under assignment from the office has been removed, defaced, covered,
30 altered, or destroyed, for the purpose of concealing or misrepresenting the
31 identity of the motor vehicle or engine, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

32 (b) Any person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, or is found
33 guilty of a second or subsequent offense shall be guilty of a Class D felony.
