20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-807(a), concerning the minimum
23 payments under the fire pension and relief funds, is amended to read as
24 follows:

25 (a)~~(1)~~(A) For volunteer fire fighters, in no case shall the payment to
26 any retired member be less than ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ one hundred dollars
27 (\$100) per month, and the payment shall be made in accordance with the
28 justice and equity of each case as determined by the board of trustees of the
29 firemen's relief and pension fund.

30 ~~(B) The benefits provided for in this subdivision (a)(1)~~
31 ~~shall only be paid provided the retirement funds are actuarially sound after~~
32 ~~the increase as determined by the actuary for the Arkansas Fire and Police~~
33 ~~Pension Review Board.~~

34 ~~(2) In no case shall the payment to any retired member be less~~
35 ~~than thirty dollars (\$30.00) per month, and the payment shall be made in~~
36 ~~accordance with the justice and equity of each case as determined by the~~
