19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Whenever a criminal background check is performed on a  
22 person under the provisions of any criminal background check requirement  
23 contained in the Arkansas Code for employment, licensure, or any other  
24 purpose, the person may be disqualified for employment, licensure, or any  
25 other purpose for which the background check was conducted if it is  
26 determined that the person committed a violation of any sexual offense  
27 formerly proscribed under Arkansas Code §§ 5-14-101 through 5-14-127 that is  
28 substantially equivalent to any sexual offense presently listed in Arkansas  
29 Code §§ 5-14-101 through 5-14-127 and is an offense screened for in a  
30 criminal background check.
