20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-63-305(b), concerning new or additional
23 positions for institutions of higher education, is amended to read as
24 follows:

26 (b) The following maximum number of new additional positions is established
27 for the biennium for the following institutions of higher education at salary
28 rates not to exceed the salary rate of comparable positions established in
29 the regular salaries section of the biennial appropriations act for
30 operations for each institution:

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that various changes in law are needed for the institutions of higher education including the authorization of additional positions due to additional funds received other than general revenue for various programs. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2003.
