Juri sdi cti on. 31 (a) Except as otherwise provided by law, the Arkansas State Claims 32 Commission shall have exclusive jurisdiction over all claims against the 33 State of Arkansas and its several agencies, departments, and institutions but shall have no jurisdiction of claims against municipalities, counties, school 34 35 districts, or any other political subdivisions of the state. (b)(1)(A)(i) The commission shall have no jurisdiction of, or 36

- 2 Law, § 11-9-101 et seq., the Arkansas Employment Security Law, § 11-10-101 et

- 27 (B) The commission shall have no jurisdiction over claims
- 28 for state tax refunds under § 26-18-507, claims challenging tax assessments
- 29 under § 26-18-406, and claims challenging tax laws under Arkansas
- 30 Constitution, Art. 16, § 13.
- 31 (3)(A) The commission shall make no award for any claim which,
- 32 as a matter of law, would be dismissed from a court of law or equity for
- 33 reasons other than sovereign immunity.
- 34 (B) Specifically, if the facts of a given claim would
- 35 cause the claim to be dismissed as a matter of law from a court of general
- 36 jurisdiction, then the commission shall make no award on the claim.

2	eligibility, qualification, or election to serve as a member of the House of
3	Representatives of the General Assembly, for the purpose of making a
4	nonbinding recommendation thereon to that chamber of the General Assembly.
