16 TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE §§ 10-3-802 AND
17 10-3-901 TO REVISE THE SENATE MEMBERSHIP
18 OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND THE
19 JOINT PERFORMANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-802(b)(1)(A), establishing the number
25 of Senate members of the Joint Committee on Energy, is amended to read as
26 follows:

27 (A) ~~Seven (7)~~ Ten (10) members of the Senate to be named pursuant to
28 the Senate Rules; and
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30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 10-3-901(a) is amended to read as follows:

31 (a) (1) There is hereby created the "Joint Performance Review
32 Committee", which shall consist of twenty (20) members of the House of
33 Representatives to be selected as prescribed by House Rule and ~~seven (7)~~ ten
34 (10) members of the Senate to be appointed pursuant to the Senate Rules.

35 (2) There shall be a Senate cochair and a House cochair and a
36 Senate vice chair and a House vice chair of the committee.

1 (3) The House cochair and House vice chair shall be selected
2 according to House Rules.

3 (4) The Senate cochair and Senate vice chair shall be selected
4 according to Senate Rules.

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6 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
7 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Senate Rules adopted for
8 the Eighty-fourth General Assembly provide for ten (10) Senate members on the
9 Joint Committee on Energy and ten (10) Senate members on the Joint
10 Performance Review Committee; that the statutes relating to those committees
11 indicate seven (7) Senate members on each committee; that the statutes
12 further provide that the Senate members are selected according to Senate
13 Rules; that until the statutes are amended, there will be a conflict between
14 the Senate Rules and the statutes; and that it is imperative that the Senate
15 Rules and the statutes not be in conflict. Therefore, an emergency is
16 declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
17 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
18 on:

19 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

20 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
21 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
22 bill; or

23 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
24 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
