AN ACT TO REVISE THE PROCEDURE FOR VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO REVISE THE PROCEDURE FOR VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-409(b)(5), concerning materials furnished to qualified voters, is amended to read as follows:
(5) A blank voter statement in the following form:
"I reside at the address indicated on my application.
I have enclosed my ballot stub in the Return Envelope. and I have enclosed my marked ballot in the Ballot Only envelope, which I will place in the Return Envelope. I will not vote again in this election. THE INFORMATION I HAVE PROVIDED IS TRUE TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY. IF I HAVE PROVIDED FALSE INFORMATION, I MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP TO TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS ( $\$ 10,000$ ) OR IMPRISONMENT FOR UP TO TEN (10) YEARS, OR BOTH, UNDER FEDERAL OR STATE LAWS.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 7-5-412(a) and (b), concerning marking and returning absentee ballots, is amended to read as follows:
(a) Upon receiving the blank ballot, statement, and envelopes, whether in the office of the county clerk or elsewhere, the voter shall mark the ballot, tear off the lower ballot stub end, and place the ballot in the provided envelope. He or she shall then seal the envelope containing place the ballot, the and place it with his executed statement, and the ballot stub in the other provided envelope.
(b) The envelope containing ballot, ballot stub, and statement must be received in the office of the county clerk not later than 7:30 p.m. on the day of the election.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 7-5-416(b)(1)(B), concerning the counting of absentee ballots, is amended to read as follows:
(B) As each outer envelope is opened and the name of the voter is read, the election officials for the absentee box shall list in duplicate the name and voting precinct of the voter and shall write on the stub end of the ballot taken from the outer envelope the number of the voter taken from this list of voters;

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 7-5-416(d), concerning the counting of absentee ballots, is amended to read as follows:
(d) It is the intent of this section to permit the election officials for absentee ballots to meet and open the outer envelope and make a list in duplicate of the name and voting precinct of each voter casting an absentee ballot, to write on the stub end of the ballot taken from the outer envelope the number of the voter taken from the list of voters, and to deposit the inner envelope containing the ballot in the ballot box and to deposit the ballot stub ends in another ballot box prior to the closing of the polls on
