24	SECTION 1. Estab	olishment of the Arkansas Heavy Equ	ipment Operator

26	(a)(1) The Arkan	nsas Heavy Equipment Operator Train	ing Academy is

28	(2) The ac	cademy shall be the Arkansas single	-source academy

1	Director shall follow hiring procedures approved by the South Arkansas		
2	Community College President in recommending academy personnel for hire.		
3	(B) The South Arkansas Community College President shall		
4	exercise final approval over the hiring of academy personnel.		
5	(2) Persons employed by the academy as of the date this act		
6	becomes effective shall be retained unless they fail to fulfill their		
7	assigned duties or lack of enrollment in or funding of the academy		
8	necessitates staff reduction.		
9	(3) The salaries of persons who are employed by the academy as		
10	of the date this act becomes effective shall not be reduced as a result of		
11	this act.		
12	(4) Persons who are nonclassified employees and faculty of the		
13	academy as of the date this act becomes effective will remain under the		
14	academy's pay schedule.		
15	(5) Persons employed by the academy as of the date this act		
16	becomes effective may join the South Arkansas Community College's Fringe		
17	Benefits Package, which includes the Arkansas Teacher Retirement Plan.		
18	(6) South Arkansas Community College will accept any leave		
19	balances for academy personnel that have accrued as of the date this act		
20	becomes effective, if the leave balance does not exceed the maximum leave		
21	allowed under Arkansas law.		
22	(b) The academy director will report directly to the South Arkansas		
23	Community College President regarding the operation of the academy.		
24	(c) The academy shall continue to offer certificates and diplomas for		
25	the training of heavy equipment operators.		
26	(d) The Arkansas Heavy Equipment Operator Training Academy Advisory		
27	Committee shall continue to make recommendations regarding the operation of		
28	the academy and its curriculum.

30	SECTION 3. <u>Funding.</u>		
31	(a)(1) All legislatively appropriated funds, tuitions, grant moneys,		
32	and donations designated for the academy shall be specifically used for the		
33	operation of the academy.		
34	(2) All moneys appropriated or designated for the academy shal		
35	be maintained:		
36	(A) In accounts separate from accounts for South Arkansas		

1	Community College;		
2	(B) In Bradley County financial institutions, whenever		
3	possible; and		
4	(C) Following state accounting procedures and guidelines.		
5	(3) The director of the academy will develop, recommend, and		
6	monitor the academy's annual budget.		
7	(4) The chief fiscal officer of the South Arkansas Community		
8	College, or his or her designee, shall regularly monitor academy books,		
9	banking records, accounts, and expenditures.		
10	(b)(1) The academy shall remain under the supervision of the academy		
11	director, who shall be assisted by the academy coordinator.		
12	(2) The Southeast Arkansas Community Based Education Center		
13	Director may serve as the director of the academy.		
14			
15	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
16	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the failure to establish the		
17	Arkansas Heavy Equipment Operator Training Academy as a single-source academy		
18	under the South Arkansas Community College will result in the expiration of		
19	the academy's training program and in the academy's inability to finish		
20	training its currently enrolled students; that the Arkansas Constitution		
21	prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period;		
22	that it is essential to the operation of the academy that this become		
23	effective on July 1, 2003; and that in the event of an extension of the		
24	Regular Session, a delay in the effective date of this act beyond July 1,		
25	2003, could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and		
26	provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is		
27	hereby declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of		
28	the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2003.
