## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-14-112 is amended to read as follows:
5-14-112. Indecent exposure.
(a) A person commits indecent exposure if, with purpose to arouse or gratify the sexual desire of the person or of any other person, the person exposes his or her sex organs:
(1) In a public place or public view; or
(2) Under circumstances in which the person knows the conduct is likely to cause affront or alarm.
(b)(l) Indecent exposure is a Class A misdemeanor.
(2)(A) If the indecent exposure is committed against a person under the age of fifteen (15) years, but greater than eleven (11) years, a second or subsequent offense of indecent exposure against a person under the age of fifteen (15) years, but greater than eleven (11) years, shall be a Class D felony.
(B) Subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this section shall not apply
if the actor is under the age of eighteen (18) years at the time of the offense.
