19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
20		
21	SECTION 1. (a) The General Assembly recognizes the need to have well-	-
22	qualified staff in sufficient numbers to carry out the duties of the	
23	Department of Education.	
24	(b) The General Assembly further recognizes that it is the	
25	constitutional duty of the General Assembly to fix, by law, the number and	
26	salaries of the employees of the departments of the State of Arkansas.	
27	(c) Therefore, an audit of the staffing needs of the department should	
28	be conducted to assist the General Assembly in making appropriate decisions	
29	regarding the organization and staffing of the department.	
30		
31	SECTION 2. (a) The House Interim Committee on Education and the	
32	Senate Interim Committee on Education shall meet jointly as necessary to	
33	conduct an audit of the staffing needs of the Department of Education.	
34	(b) The committees shall:	
35	(1) Conduct an audit of the staffing needs of the department;	
36	(2) Recommend to the Eighty Fifth General Assembly any changes	



1	in the department's staff positions, salaries, grades, or titles that are
2	determined to improve the department's ability to perform its functions and
3	duties; and
4	(3) Recommend the amount of appropriations that will be
5	necessary to provide adequate staffing at the department, or its successors;
6	(c) The committees shall report their findings and recommendations to
7	the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
8	Representatives, and the Governor no later than August 1, 2004.
9	(d)(1) The Director of the Department of Education, or his or her
10	designee, shall attend all joint meetings conducted to fulfill the
11	requirements of this act.
12	(2) The department shall provide the committees with assistance
13	or information as requested by the committees.
14	(e) The committees may contract with individuals or entities to
15	conduct the audit of the department's staffing needs to the extent funding is
16	appropriated and available for that purpose.
17	(f) The Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council
18	Disbursing Officer shall disburse funds for the audit of the department's
19	staffing needs from the Interim Committee Study Expenses appropriation.

21	SECTION 3. This act shall expire on March 1, 2005.
22	
23	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
24	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that a review of the Department of
25	Education's staffing needs must be conducted. The committee work must be
26	started in sufficient time to complete the audit and make recommendations
27	prior to the Eighty Fifth General Assembly. Therefore, an emergency is
28	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
29	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
30	<u>on:</u>
31	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
32	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
33	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
34	bill; or
35	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the
36	Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the

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l <u>veto.</u>
