25	(a) As used in this section:
26	(1)(A) "Covered police officer" means:
27	(i) Any employee of the Department of Arkansas State

29	<u>(a) Holds the rank of state trooper or a</u>

31	(b) Has been an employee of the
32	department for ten (10) or more years;
33	(ii) Any highway police officer who has been an
34	employee of the Arkansas Highway Police Division of the Arkansas State

1	(iii) Any officer of the State Capitol Police who
2	has been an employee of the State Capitol Police for ten (10) or more years;

4	(iv) Any wildlife officer who has been an employee

6	(B) "Covered police officer" does not include:
7	(i) A civilian employee; or
8	(ii) A person who is temporarily employed as a
9	covered police officer due to an emergency situation;
10	(2) "Dependent" means:
11	(A) Any natural child, stepchild, or adopted child of a
12	covered police officer; and
13	(B) Any individual of whom a covered police officer is the
14	<u>legal guardian;</u>
15	(3) "Public institution of higher education" means a public
16	university, college, technical college, or community college; and
17	(4)(A) "Tuition" means charges levied for attendance at an
18	institution of higher education.
19	(B) "Tuition" does not include any fees charged or used
20	for student activities, including without limitation any student athletic
21	<u>fee.</u>
22	(b)(1) Any covered police officer or his or her dependent who is
23	enrolled or has been accepted for enrollment in a public institution of
24	higher education in Arkansas may have tuition reduced at a rate equal to the
25	reduced rate of tuition provided to employees of that public institution of
26	higher education if his or her employer elects to offer reduced tuition.
27	(2) An employer of a covered police officer may elect to offer
28	reduced tuition based on the amount of funds available.
29	(3) If the employer of the covered police officer elects to
30	offer reduced tuition, the employer shall pay to the public institution of
31	higher education the difference between the regular tuition rate and the
32	reduced rate of tuition provided to employees of the public institution of
33	higher education.
34	(c) No covered police officer or his or her dependent may utilize the
35	reduced rate of tuition for educational purposes beyond the baccalaureate
36	<u>degree.</u>

1	(d) The employer of a covered police officer electing to offer reduced
2	tuition for covered police officers shall develop criteria regarding the
3	awarding of reduced tuition, including without limitation:
4	(1) Academic requirements to continue receiving reduced tuition;
5	(2) The length of time reduced tuition may be offered;
6	(3) Procedures to be followed in the event the covered police
7	officer or his or her dependent experiences a severe personal illness, a
8	medical disability, or activation for full-time military service; and
9	(4) Appeal procedures that a covered police officer may follow
10	if his or her reduced tuition is discontinued by the employer.
