11	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
12	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the need to maintain correct
13	information regarding the location of the residences of sex offenders is
14	necessary to ensure the safety of the citizens of the State of Arkansas; that
15	the provisions of this act will require sex offenders to maintain correct
16	information on identification cards and driver's licenses; and that this act
17	is necessary because of the public risk posed by sex offenders. Therefore,
18	an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary
19	for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
20	effective on:
21	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
22	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
23	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
24	bill; or
25	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
26	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
