24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 38, Subchapter 1 is amended
27	to add an additional section to read as follows:
28	17-38-106. Water distribution piping under concrete slabs.
29	(a)(1) Inaccessible water distribution piping under concrete slabs may
30	be cross-linked Polyethylene PEX (SDR9) pipe.
31	(2) Cross-linked Polyethylene PEX (SDR9) pipe shall meet ASTM F-
32	876/F-877, and NSP standards 14 and 61.
33	
34	SECTION 2. If the 2006 State Plumbing Code includes the same
35	provisions as in SECTION 1 of this act, this act expires on the effective



1	<u>date of the 2006 State Plumbing Code.</u>
2	
3	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
4	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that ongoing construction projects
5	will be slowed and their costs increased until PEX pipe is approved for
6	installation under concrete slabs; that proposed construction projects will
7	be on hold and their costs increased until PEX pipe is approved for
8	installation under concrete slabs; and that this act is necessary because the
9	construction industry and prospective home owners will suffer irreparable
10	harm until this act becomes effective. Therefore, an emergency is declared
11	to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public
12	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on June 1, 2007.
