22	(a) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle, except when
23	necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the
24	directions of a police officer or traffic-control device, in any of the
25	following places:
26	(1) On a sidewalk;
27	(2) In front of a public or private driveway;
28	(3) Within an intersection;
29	(4) Within fifteen feet (15') of a fire hydrant;
30	(5) On a crosswalk;
31	(6) Within twenty feet (20') of a crosswalk at an intersection;
32	(7) Within thirty feet (30') upon the approach to any flashing
33	beacon, stop sign, or traffic-control signal located at the side of a
34	roadway;
35	(8) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty
