19 (a)(1) Release of criminal history information under this subchapter
20 shall be made only by the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas
21 State Police and the Arkansas Crime Information Center as authorized by law.

(2) The Department of Arkansas State Police and the center may
adopt rules and regulations consistent with the provisions and intent of this
subchapter.

(b) The department and the center may contract with the Information Network of Arkansas under the Information Network of Arkansas Act, § 25-27-101 et seq., or any other qualified third-party vendor in the establishment of the gateway or means of electronically processing transactions under this subchapter.

30 (c)(1) The department shall not process a request for a Federal Bureau 31 of Investigation background check unless a corresponding state background 32 check through the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State 33 Police has also been properly requested pursuant to this subchapter.
