## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO SEPARATE THE OFFICES OF SHERIFF AND TAX COLLECTOR IN MONROE COUNTY; TO CONSOLIDATE THE OFFICES OF TAX COLLECTOR AND COUNTY TREASURER IN MONROE COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO SEPARATE THE OFFICES OF SHERIFF AND TAX COLLECTOR AND TO CONSOLIDATE THE OFFICES OF TAX COLLECTOR AND COUNTY TREASURER IN MONROE COUNTY. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. (a) Effective January 1, 2011, the offices of sheriff and tax collector in Monroe County, Arkansas, shall be separate offices.
(b) Effective January 1, 2011, the offices of tax collector and treasurer shall be consolidated into one (1) office.
(c) At the 2010 general election, the qualified electors of Monroe County shall elect a sheriff and a tax collector-treasurer, and each officer so elected shall take office on January 1, 2011.
(d) The sheriff and tax collector-treasurer in Monroe County shall each give bond for the faithful performance of their duties as is provided by 1aw.

SECTION 2. The sheriff and tax collector-treasurer of Monroe County
shall each receive compensation as shall be determined by the Monroe County Quorum Court within the minimum and maximum compensation range prescribed by the General Assembly, and shall hire deputies and have other allowances as prescribed by the Monroe County Quorum Court.
