33	elbows, hips, or knees are immovable.			
34	(b) Licensed nur	(b) Licensed nurses employed by nursing facilities may withhold		
35	cardiopulmonary resuscitation from residents of the facility, regardless of			

1	the presence or absence of a Do Not Resuscitate order when:			
2	(1) The death of the resident was unwitnessed; and			
3	(2) The body evidences clear and unmistakable dependent			
4	<u>lividity; or</u>			
5	(3) The body evidences clear and unmistakable rigor.			
6	(c) In cases of unwitnessed deaths under subsection (b) of this			
7	section, the following conditions also must be present:			
8	(1) Respirations are absent for at least thirty (30) seconds;			
9	(2) Carotid pulse is absent for at least thirty (30) seconds;			
10	(3) Lung sounds auscultated by stethoscope bilaterally are

12	(4) Both pupils, if accessible, are nonreactive to light.			
13	(d) The nursing facility shall document the presence of the above-

15	(e)(1) Nursing facilities and licensed nurses of nursing facilities

17	for administrative sanctions, civil damages, or subject to criminal
