17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-5-302(5) is amended to read as follows to
20 correct the name of a fund account:

21 (5)(A) ~~Department of~~ Arkansas Economic Development Commission
22 Fund Account. The ~~Department of~~ Arkansas Economic Development Commission Fund
23 Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement
24 required by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission and the Arkansas
25 Economic Development Council in carrying out the powers, functions, and
26 duties as set out in §§ 15-4-101, 15-4-102, 15-4-201 - 15-4-204, 15-4-206,
27 15-4-209 - 15-4-212, 15-4-501 - 15-4-524, and 15-10-201 - 15-10-206, or other
28 duties imposed by law upon the Arkansas Economic Development Commission or
29 the Arkansas Energy Office.

30 (B) The ~~Department of~~ Arkansas Economic Development Commission
31 Fund Account shall consist of:

- 32 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;
33 (ii) Non-revenue income derived from services performed by
34 the various divisions of the Arkansas Economic Development Council; and
35 (iii) Any other funds that may be provided by law;
36



1 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-5-303(ee)(3), concerning the National Park
2 Community College Fund, is amended to read as follows:

3 (3) The National Park Community College Fund shall consist of:

4 (A) Those general revenues transferred each month from the
5 Garland County Community College Fund ~~and the Quapaw Technical Institute Fund~~
6 ~~Account~~;

7 (B) The June 30, 2003, balances in the Garland County Community
8 College Fund ~~and the Quapaw Technical Institute Fund Account~~; and

9 (C) Any other funds made available for the support of the
10 National Park Community College which are required to be deposited into the
11 State Treasury by law.

12
13 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 19-5-304 concerning the Education Fund, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 19-5-304. Education Fund.

16 The Education Fund shall consist of the following funds and fund accounts
17 made available for the support of the Department of Education and the
18 Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education and shall be used for the same
19 purposes as set out for the following fund accounts:

20 (1)(A) Department of Education Fund Account. The Department of
21 Education Fund Account shall be used to provide for the maintenance,
22 operation, and improvement of the Department of Education as created by § 6-
23 10-101 et seq., and any other laws imposing functions, powers, and duties
24 upon the State Board of Education, the Department of Education, and the
25 Commissioner of Education, including, but not necessarily limited to, history
26 textbooks expenses, the Publishing Revolving Account, audio-visual services,
27 textbooks operation, compact for education, including the state's membership,
28 and the state's contribution to the Southern Regional Education Board.

29 (B) The Department of Education Fund Account shall consist of:

30 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by the
31 Revenue Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.; and

32 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by
33 those programs supported from the Department of Education Fund Account,
34 including any rental property located on the State Capitol grounds owned by
35 the Department of Education;

36 (2)(A) Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education Fund Account. The

1 Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education Fund Account shall be used to
2 provide support for those programs placed under the direction of the Director
3 of the Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education as authorized by §§ 6-11-101,
4 6-11-102, 25-6-101, 25-6-102, and Acts 1981, No. 64, § 4, and any other laws
5 imposing functions, powers, and duties upon the State Board of ~~Workforce~~
6 Career Education and ~~Career Opportunities~~, including, but not necessarily
7 limited to, the following:

8 (i) Vocational, technical, and adult education;
9 (ii) Adult basic education;
10 (iii) Manpower training;
11 (iv) Vocational standards;
12 (v) Industry training programs; and
13 (vi) Those functions, programs, and responsibilities
14 transferred to the Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education as authorized by
15 these statutes.

16 (B) The Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education Fund Account
17 shall consist of those general revenues as may be provided by the Revenue
18 Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.;

19 (3)(A) Educational Television Fund Account. The Educational
20 Television Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and
21 improvement required by the Educational Television Division of the Department
22 of Education in carrying out those powers, functions, and duties of the
23 Arkansas Educational Television Commission as set out in § 6-3-101 et seq. or
24 other duties imposed by law upon the commission.

25 (B) The Educational Television Fund Account shall consist of
26 those general revenues as may be provided by law and nonrevenue income
27 derived from services provided by the Educational Television Division and any
28 other nonfederal grant funds provided by law;

29 (4)(A) State Library Fund Account. The State Library Fund Account
30 shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the
31 Library Division of the Department of Education in carrying out the powers,
32 functions, and duties as set out in § 13-2-201 et seq. or any other duties
33 imposed by law upon the State Library Commission, which were transferred to
34 the Department of Education by §§ 6-11-101, 6-11-102, and 25-6-102.

35 (B) The State Library Fund Account shall consist of those
36 general revenues as may be provided by law and nonrevenue income derived from

1 services provided by the Library Division of the Department of Education and
2 any other nonfederal grant funds provided by law;

3 (5)(A) School for the Blind Fund Account. The School for the Blind
4 Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement
5 required by the Arkansas School for the Blind in carrying out those powers,
6 functions, and duties as set out in § 6-43-101 et seq. and § 6-43-201 et seq.

7 (B) The School for the Blind Fund Account shall consist of those
8 general revenues as may be provided by law and nonrevenue income derived from
9 services provided by the Arkansas School for the Blind and any other
10 nonfederal grant funds provided by law.

11 (C) Federal reimbursement funds received on account of
12 vocational education programs conducted by the Arkansas School for the Blind
13 shall not be deposited to the School for the Blind Fund Account;

14 (6)(A) School for the Deaf Fund Account. The School for the Deaf Fund
15 Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement
16 required by the Arkansas School for the Deaf in carrying out the powers,
17 functions, and duties as set out in § 6-43-301 et seq. or other duties
18 imposed by law upon the Arkansas School for the Deaf, which were transferred
19 to the Department of Education by §§ 6-11-101, 6-11-102, and 25-6-102.

20 (B) The School for the Deaf Fund Account shall consist of those
21 general revenues as may be provided by law and nonrevenue income derived from
22 services provided by the Arkansas School for the Deaf and any other
23 nonfederal grant funds provided by law.

24 (C) Federal reimbursement funds received on account of
25 vocational education programs conducted by the Arkansas School for the Deaf
26 shall not be deposited to this account;

27 (7)(A) Rehabilitation Services Fund Account. The Rehabilitation
28 Services Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and
29 improvement required by the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services of the
30 Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education in carrying out the powers,
31 functions, and duties, as set out in § 6-52-101 et seq., § 20-79-201 et seq.,
32 and § 25-30-201 et seq., and for the adult handicapped program at the
33 Arkansas Health Center.

34 (B) The Rehabilitation Services Fund Account shall consist of:

35 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

36 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by

1 rehabilitation programs of the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services of the
2 Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education; and

3 (iii) Any other nonfederal grant funds provided by law;

4 (8)~~(A)~~ Technical Institute and Other Education Fund Accounts. ~~The~~
5 ~~Arkansas Tech University—Ozark Campus Fund Account shall be used for the~~
6 ~~maintenance, operation, and improvement of Arkansas Tech University—Ozark~~
7 ~~Campus. The Arkansas Tech University—Ozark Campus Fund Account shall~~
8 ~~consist of:~~

9 ~~(i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; and~~

10 ~~—————(ii) Any other funds made available for the support of~~
11 ~~Arkansas Tech University—Ozark Campus that are required to be deposited~~
12 ~~into the State Treasury by law.~~

13 ~~(B)~~ (A) The Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute Fund Account
14 shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement of the
15 Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute. The Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute
16 Fund Account shall consist of:

17 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; and

18 (ii) Any other funds made available for the support of the
19 Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute which are required to be deposited into
20 the State Treasury by law.

21 ~~(C)~~ (B) The Northwest Technical Institute Fund Account shall be
22 used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement of the Northwest
23 Technical Institute. The Northwest Technical Institute Fund Account shall
24 consist of:

25 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; and

26 (ii) Any other funds made available for the support of the
27 Northwest Technical Institute which are required to be deposited into the
28 State Treasury by law.

29 ~~(D)~~ ~~The Quapaw Technical Institute Fund Account shall be used~~
30 ~~for the maintenance, operation, and improvement of the Quapaw Technical~~
31 ~~Institute. The Quapaw Technical Institute Fund Account shall consist of:~~

32 ~~—————(i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; and~~

33 ~~—————(ii) Any other funds made available for the support of the~~
34 ~~Quapaw Technical Institute which are required to be deposited into the State~~
35 ~~Treasury by law.~~

36 ~~(E)~~ (C) The Riverside Vocational Technical School Fund Account

1 shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement of the
2 Riverside Vocational Technical School. The Riverside Vocational Technical
3 School Fund Account shall consist of:

4 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; and
5 (ii) Any other funds made available for the support of the
6 Riverside Vocational Technical School which are required to be deposited into
7 the State Treasury by law;

8 (9)(A) Educational Facilities Partnership Fund Account. The
9 Educational Facilities Partnership Fund Account shall be used for
10 distribution of grants for programs providing academic school facility and
11 transportation assistance to the public school districts as may be provided
12 by law.

13 (B) The Educational Facilities Partnership Fund Account shall
14 consist of:

15 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;
16 (ii) Moneys transferred from the General Improvement Fund;
17 and

18 (iii) Any other moneys as may be provided by law; and

19 (10)(A) Division of Public School Academic Facilities and
20 Transportation Fund Account. The Division of Public School Academic
21 Facilities and Transportation Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance,
22 operation, and improvement required by the Division of Public School Academic
23 Facilities and Transportation of the Department of Education as may be
24 provided by law.

25 (B) The Division of Public School Academic Facilities and
26 Transportation Fund Account shall consist of:

27 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law; and
28 (ii) Any other funds made available for the support of the
29 Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation of the
30 Department of Education.

31

32 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code §19-5-305, concerning the Public School Fund,
33 is amended to read as follows:

34 19-5-305. Public School Fund.

35 (a) The Public School Fund shall consist of the following fund accounts
36 and funds made available for the support of the Department of Education, ~~the~~

1 ~~Department of Workforce Education,~~ and the Arkansas State Library of the
2 Department of Education and the Department of Career Education, and shall be
3 used for the same purposes as set out for the following fund accounts:

4 (1) Department of Education Public School Fund Account. The
5 Department of Education Public School Fund Account shall be used for grants
6 and aids for the programs administered by the Department of Education
7 ~~consisting of, but not limited to,~~ as authorized by law.

- 8 ~~(A) Teacher retirement matching;~~
- 9 ~~_____ (B) Handicapped children;~~
- 10 ~~_____ (C) Aid to the county general;~~
- 11 ~~_____ (D) Guidance services;~~
- 12 ~~_____ (E) Transportation aid;~~
- 13 ~~_____ (F) State equalization aid;~~
- 14 ~~_____ (G) State apportionment;~~

25 (2) Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education Public School Fund
26 Account. The Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education Public School Fund
27 Account shall be used for grants and aids for the programs administered by
28 the Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education consisting of, but not limited
29 to:

- 30 (A) General adult education grants;
- 31 (B) Adult basic education grants;
- 32 (C) Manpower development and training grants;
- 33 (D) Vocational-technical and adult education; and
- 34 (E) Such other grants and aids as may be authorized by law for
35 disbursement by the Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education; and

36 (3) State Library Public School Fund Account. The State Library

1 Public School Fund Account shall be used for Aid to Public Libraries as
2 administered by the Arkansas State Library of the Department of Education.

3 (b) The Public School Fund shall consist of those moneys as may be
4 provided by:

5 (1) The Revenue Stabilization Law, § 19-5-101 et seq.;

6 (2) Any federal mineral leasing funds, federal forest reserve funds,
7 federal flood control funds, or any other similar turnback funds in the State
8 Treasury for which the eligible county or school district cannot be
9 identified;

10 (3) Fines collected pursuant to § 6-21-410 under the Free Textbook Act
11 of 1975, § 6-21-401 et seq.;

12 (4) Funds remitted by county treasurers for those school districts
13 which have local revenue per student in excess of the local base per student,
14 as set out in § 26-80-101(c);

15 (5) Amusement machine revenues up to and including thirty thousand
16 dollars (\$30,000), as set out in § 26-57-407;

17 (6) Additional rental vehicle tax revenues in excess of two million
18 eight hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$2,850,000), § 26-63-302, to be
19 used exclusively for teacher salaries; and

20 (7) Such other funds as may be authorized by law.

21 (c)(1) There is authorized a transfer of up to two hundred thousand dollars
22 (\$200,000) per year from the Public School Fund to the Department of
23 Education Fund Account or the Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education Fund
24 Account, or a portion thereof to both, by the Treasurer of State and the
25 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, upon certification as to the amount
26 required by the Commissioner of Education or by the Director of the
27 Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education, or both, to the Chief Fiscal
28 Officer of the State.

29 (2) This transfer shall be used to provide additional support for the
30 administration of the handicapped children program and the vocational-
31 technical and adult education program.

32

33 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 19-5-306(1) concerning the Department of Human
34 Services Fund, is amended to read as follows:

35 19-5-306. Department of Human Services Fund.

36 The Department of Human Services Fund shall consist of the following fund

1 accounts and funds made available for the support of the Department of Human
2 Services and shall be used for the same purposes as set out for the following
3 fund accounts:

4 (1)(A) ~~Mental~~ Behavioral Health Services Fund Account. The ~~Mental~~
5 Behavioral Health Services Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance,
6 operation, and improvement required by the Division of Behavioral Health of
7 the Department of Human Services in carrying out the powers, functions, and
8 duties, as set out in § 20-46-101 et seq. and § 25-10-101 et seq., or other
9 duties imposed by law upon the Arkansas State Hospital.

10 (B) The ~~Mental~~ Behavioral Health Services Fund Account shall
11 consist of:

12 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

13 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by
14 the Arkansas State Hospital;

15 (iii) Federal reimbursement received on account of
16 eligible expenditures;

17 (iv) Paying patient fees and other funds as may be
18 provided by law;

19 (v) Funds received from local sources for community
20 program matching; and

21 (vi) Funds received from the Division of Medical Services
22 of the Department of Human Services;

23

24 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code 19-5-501(b)(1)(C), concerning the Budget
25 Stabilization Trust Fund, is amended to read as follows:

26 (C) The loans made to the Income Tax Refund Fund, to the Gasoline Tax
27 Refund Fund, to the Interstate Motor Fuel Tax Refund Fund, and to those other
28 funds established in the Revenue Classification Law, § 19-6-101 et seq., are
29 to be repaid on the last day of the month of which the loan was made.

30 However, loans made to the Department of Human Services Fund during June of
31 any fiscal year for making cash assistance payments to eligible individuals
32 under the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program for delivery on or
33 about July 1 of the following fiscal year shall be repaid on or before July
34 31 of the fiscal year following the fiscal year in which the loan was made;

35 and loans made to the Department of Human Services for the Developmental
36 Disabilities Services Fund Account and the ~~Mental~~ Behavioral Health Services

1 Fund Account in the last month of a fiscal year for federal reimbursement for
2 Medicaid and Medicare eligible services shall be repaid immediately upon
3 receipt of reimbursement but no later than July 31 of the fiscal year
4 following the fiscal year in which the loan was made.

5
6 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code 19-5-1043(b)(2), concerning the Drug Abuse
7 Prevention and Treatment Fund, is amended to read as follows:

8 (2) Such general revenue as transferred from the ~~Mental~~ Behavioral
9 Health Services Fund Account;

10
11 SECTION 8. Any funds appropriated by the Eighty-Eighth General Assembly
12 from the Department of Workforce Education Fund Account shall be deemed
13 payable from the Department of Career Education Fund Account.

14
15 SECTION 9. Any funds appropriated by the Eighty-Eighth General Assembly
16 from the Department of Workforce Education Public School Fund Account shall
17 be deemed payable from the Department of Career Education Public School Fund
18 Account.

19
20 SECTION 10. Any funds appropriated by the Eighty-Eighth General
21 Assembly from the Mental Health Services Fund Account shall be deemed payable
22 from the Behavioral Health Services Fund Account.

23
24 SECTION 11. Any funds appropriated by the Eighty-Eighth General
25 Assembly from the Department of Economic Development Fund Account shall be
26 deemed payable from the Arkansas Economic Development Commission Fund
27 Account.

28
29 SECTION 12. *NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR*
30 *PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER.*
31 *Immediately upon the effective date of this act, or as soon thereafter as is*
32 *practicable, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or*
33 *her books and those of the State Treasurer and Auditor of State the sum of*
34 *twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) from the cash funds of the State Land*
35 *Department to the Merit Adjustment Fund.*

36

1 SECTION 13. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR
2 PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER.
3 Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of
4 the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer
5 and Auditor of State the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) from the Red
6 River Waterways Project Trust Fund to the Merit Adjustment Fund.

7
8 SECTION 14. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR
9 PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DEPARTMENT OF
10 WORKFORCE SERVICES LOAN AND FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective
11 date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall record as a
12 loan and transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and
13 Auditor of State the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) from the
14 Workforce Services Special Fund to the Merit Adjustment Fund.

15
16 SECTION 15. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR
17 PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFERS.
18 At the direction of the Governor and upon review by the Arkansas Legislative
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
20 shall have the authority to cause a transfer of funds distributed to the
21 Educational Facilities Partnership Fund Account from distributions made under
22 the Revenue Stabilization Law during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, to
23 any other fund or fund account established by law.

24
25 SECTION 16. Arkansas Code 19-5-401 is amended to read as follows:
26 19-5-401. Allocations for fiscal year 2011-2012 and thereafter.
27 Commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2011, and each fiscal year
28 thereafter, the Treasurer of State shall transfer all remaining general
29 revenues available for distribution on the last day of business in July 2011,
30 and on the last day of business in each calendar month thereafter during the
31 fiscal year to the various funds and fund accounts participating in general
32 revenues in the proportions of the maximum allocation as the individual
33 allocation to the fund or fund account bears to the total of the maximum
34 allocation as provided in § 19-5-402 (a) and (b).

35
36 SECTION 17. Arkansas Code 19-5-402 is amended to read as follows:

1 19-5-402. Maximum allocations of revenues for fiscal year 2011-2012 and
2 thereafter.

3 (a) The Treasurer of State shall first make monthly allocations in the
4 proportions set out in this subsection to the funds and fund accounts listed
5 below until there has been transferred a total of four billion five hundred
6 sixty-four million twenty-five thousand dollars (\$4,564,025,000) or so much
7 thereof as may become available; provided, that the Treasurer of State shall
8 make such monthly allocations in accordance with each fund or fund account's
9 proportionate part of the total of all such allocations set forth in this
10 subsection:
