## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act concerning the inclusion of service sinks in CERTAIN BUILDINGS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF SERVICE SINKS IN CERTAIN BUILDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 38, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section:

17-38-107. Service sinks.
(a)(l) As used in this section, "commercial building" means a building for the transaction of business, professional services, other services involving merchandise, office buildings, banks, light industrial and similar uses.
(2) "Commercial building" does not include a food service

## establishment.

(b) A commercial building shall not be required to include a plumbing service sink, either at construction or as part of a renovation or remodeling, if the building owner or an agent of the building owner communicates to the plumbing code official at the time of construction or renovation that the actual or proposed number of persons that will occupy the building is fifteen (15) or less.
(c) For the purposes of determining the minimum number of plumbing service sink fixtures required in a building, the number shall not be determined by using building occupancy loads as calculated in the Arkansas

Fire Prevention Code.
