It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that provisions of the Arkansas 24 25 Teacher Retirement System Act are in need of revision and updating to 26 maintain the teacher retirement laws in conformance with sound public pension 27 policy; that the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates on a July 1 to June 30 fiscal year; that having a July 1, 2013, effective date is necessary 28 29 to allow the provisions of this act to being on the first day of the fiscal year and provide proper administration of the system; and that this act is 30 necessary to maintain an orderly system of benefits for the members of the 31 Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to 32 33 exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2013. 34 35
