17	Life and Health Insurance Program requires fundamental restructuring to
18	ensure that affordable health insurance options are available to state and
19	public school employees; that an urgent need exists to start implementing the
20	necessary reforms to the State and Public School Life and Health Insurance
21	Program; and that Section 1 of this act is immediately necessary to improve
22	the financial viability of the State and Public School Life and Health
23	Insurance Program. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and Section
24	1 of this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
25	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
26	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
27	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
28	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
29	bill; or
30	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
31	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
