22	SECTION 1. APPR	ROPRIATION - JOB COUNSELING AND WORKFORC	E READINESS	
23	TRAINING. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Workforce			
24	Services, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor

26	(A) for persona	al services and operating expenses to pr	ovide job

30	SECTION 2. DISE	BURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may	be awarded nor	
31	obligations otherwise	e incurred in relation to the project or	projects	
32	described herein in e	excess of the State Treasury funds actua	lly available	
33	therefor as provided	by law. Provided, however, that instit	utions and	
34	agencies listed here	in shall have the authority to accept an	d use grants and

13 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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22 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

24 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of

the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

27 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm

29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

32 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
