28	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provi	ded, and that in
29	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the del	ay in the
30	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irr	eparable harm
31	upon the proper administration and provision of essential gov	<u>ernmental</u>
32	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist	and this Act
33	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	peace, health
34	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after J	uly 1, 2019.
