(c) interest earned on State Treasury fund balances as provided in this subsection. For the period commencing on July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999, the State Treasurer shall, after complying with provisions of

(1) Arkansas Code §27-70-204 for distributing interest income earned from investment of average daily balances of the "State Highway and Transportation Department Fund",

(2) Arkansas Code §15-41-110 for distributing interest earned from investment of average daily balances of the "Game Protection Fund",

(3) Arkansas Code §15-5-422 for the first two million dollars

SECTION 3. (A) Of those moneys accruing to the 81<sup>st</sup> Session Projects Account of the General Improvement Fund as set out in Section 2 of this Act, fifty percent (50%) shall be allocated in order to provide financing for those projects enumerated in Section 5 of this Act, and the remaining fifty percent (50%) shall be allocated to provide financing for those projects as set out in Section 4 of this Act.
