Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1010.

Amend House Bill No. 1010 as originally introduced:

Add the following Representatives as cosponsors of the bill: Stovall, Gillespie, Bolin, McMellon, Seawel, Fite

AND

Page 2, line 6, add an additional Section to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly that additional moneys are necessary to fund Arkansas</u> <u>Academic Challenge Scholarships; that this act transfers moneys for that</u> <u>purpose; and that this act is immediately necessary for the effective</u> <u>administration of this act.</u> Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and <u>this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public</u> <u>peace, health, and safety shall become effective on the date of its approval</u> <u>by the Governor.</u> If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, <u>it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during</u> <u>which the Governor may veto the bill.</u> If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last <u>house overrides the veto.</u>"
