Subtitle of House Bill No. 1018

"TO REQUIRE PERSONS OPERATING MOTORBOATS TO USE LANYARD-TYPE
ENGINE CUTOFF SWITCHES IF THE BOAT IS SO EQUIPPED."

Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1018.

Amend House Bill No. 1018 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 25, delete "(e)(1)" and substitute "(e)(1)(A)"

AND

Page 1, delete line 29, and substitute the following:

"as appropriate for the specific vessel.

(B) However, if a motorboat equipped with a lanyard-type switch is a house boat, a pontoon boat, or is traveling less than five (5) miles per hour, the lanyard shall not be required to be attached to the operator, the operator's clothing, or to the operator's personal flotation device."
