Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1029.

Amend House Bill No. 1029 as engrossed, 1/28/03:

Page 1 Line 7 delete "Roebuck,";

And

Page 1 Line 33 immediately following "agencies" insert ", boards, commissions, offices, or institutions";

And

Page 2 line 16 insert
" (7) Construction related expenditures by the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department.
(8) Expenditure of retirement systems required to cover benefit payments ." ;

And

Page 2 line 28 insert after the period "Notwithstanding the provisions of Arkansas Code 24-4-101(11)(A), the employer shall pay the required employer retirement matching amount on any lump sum paid to a member of a retirement system under the provisions of this section and the contribution shall be included in the computation of the employee's retirement benefit."
