## Amendment No. 3 to House Bill No. 1087.

Amend House Bill No. 1087 as engrossed, 2/24/03:

Page 1, delete lines 11 through 12 and substitute the following: "REQUIRE THE COURT TO ORDER THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT TO PROVIDE THE CUSTODIAL PARENT WITH PROOF OF INCOME ANY TIME A COURT ORDERS CHILD SUPPORT; TO ALLOW NONCUSTODIAL PARENT TO REQUEST PROOF OF INCOME FROM THE CUSTODIAL PARENT NO MORE THAN ONCE A YEAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 17 through 19 and substitute the following: "TO REQUIRE THE COURT TO ORDER THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT TO PROVIDE THE CUSTODIAL PARENT WITH PROOF OF INCOME ANY TIME A COURT ORDERS CHILD SUPPORT."

AND

Page 1, line 35, delete the word "annual"

AND

Page 2, line 6, delete the word "annual"

AND

Page 3, delete line 23 and substitute the following: "comply with its order for the support of the children.

SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that children are not receiving the</u> <u>amount of child support to which they are entitled under current law; that</u> <u>child support is an essential part of a custodial parent's income that is</u> <u>necessary to provide the basic needs for the child; and that this act is</u> <u>immediately necessary to prevent children from being denied the support they</u> <u>are entitled to under law and to prevent the undue delay of changes in the</u>
