Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1234.
Amend House Bill No. 1234 as originally introduced:
Page 2, delete line 7, and substitute the following: "terms.
(D)(i) The town council may refer to voters an ordinance
on the question of returning the town to electing aldermen to two-year terms
using the procedures of this subdivision (a)(2) of this section. (ii) If the voters approve returning a town to two-
year terms, all aldermen shall be elected to two-year terms at the next
general election and thereafter.
(E) The town council may not refer to voters another
question on electing aldermen to four-year terms or on returning the town to electing aldermen to two-year terms unless at least four (4) years have
passed since the last election on changing the aldermanic terms."
