Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1252.

Amend House Bill No. 1252 as originally introduced:

Delete everything following the enacting clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-10-102, concerning definitions used in the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System, is amended to read as follows:

- (21) "Normal retirement age" means the younger of the following ages:
- (A) Age fifty-five (55) if the member has at least twenty (20) years of credited service;
- (B) Age sixty (60) if the member has fewer than twenty (20) years of credited service; $\frac{\partial}{\partial x}$
- (C) Any age if the member has twenty-eight (28) or more years of credited service; or
- (D) Age fifty (50) if the member has at least twenty (20) years of credited service, if the person is receiving benefits from a police and fire pension relief fund;"
