Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1256.
Amend House Bill No. 1256 as originally introduced:
Page 2, delete line 16, and substitute the following:
"terms for the ward. (D)(i) The city council may refer to voters an ordinance
on the question of returning the city to electing aldermen to two-year terms
using the procedures of this subdivision (a)(3) of this section.
(ii) If the voters approve returning a city to two-
year terms, all aldermen shall be elected to two-year terms at the next general election and thereafter.
(E) The city council may not refer to voters another
question on electing aldermen to four-year terms or on returning the city to
electing aldermen to two-year terms unless at least four (4) years has passed
since the last election on changing the aldermanic terms."
