Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 1439.

Amend House Bill No. 1439 as engrossed, H2/21/03:

Add Representatives Lamoureux, Penix, and Medley as cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 1, line 9, delete "GRADE" and substitute "GRADES"

AND

Page 1, line 10, delete "TWELVE (12) " and substitute "NINE (9) THROUGH
TWELVE (12)"

AND

Page 1, line 15, delete "GRADE TWELVE (12) " and substitute "GRADES NINE (9)
THROUGH TWELVE (12)"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 3, and substitute the following:

"directors to develop policies to allow:

(i) Students to be assigned to no more that one (1) class
period each day for a study hall period which the student shall be required
to attend and participate in a full class period of self-study or organized
tutoring in the school building; and

(ii)(a) No more than one (1) class period each day for
organized and scheduled student extracurricular classes to be included as
planned instructional time.

Page 2, delete line 14, and substitute the following:

"public schools.

(d) Nothing in this bill precludes a student who has meet all graduation requirements from graduating early."
