Page 3, line 9 add:

"(5)(A) In the event that a petitioner's name is removed from the registry as a result of a failure to comply with this subsection (c), the Department of Human Services shall report the failure to comply to the House Interim Committee on Aging, Children and Youth, Legislative and Military Affairs and the Senate Interim Committee on Children and Youth.

(B) The reports shall be submitted quarterly with a written explanation of the department's failure to comply."
